THE DEVIL'S FACE is the second book in the series featuring the profiler Katrine Wraa. The first one, SCREAM UNDER WATER, which won the Danish newspaper Politiken's Crime Award, was published in 2010. It sold more than 70,000 copies, making it one of the year's bestsellers.

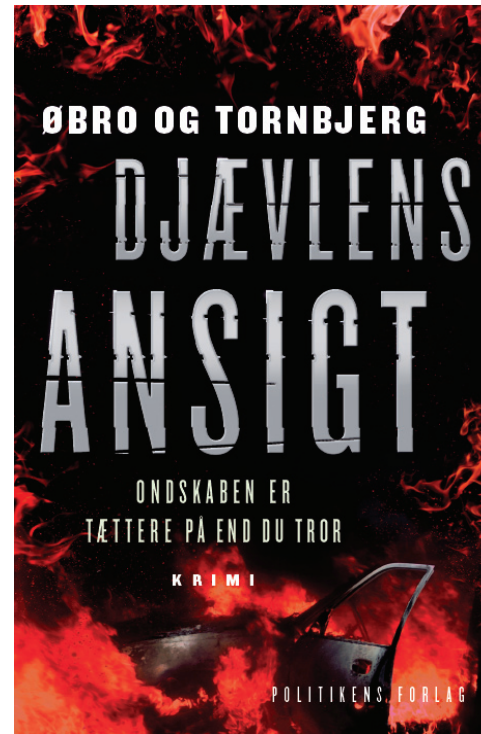
